Word of God Sunday

This 'Sunday of the Word of God' celebrates the gift of Scripture, encouraging us to listen to and live by God's word. In two of the readings, the word of God is proclaimed publicly to the people.

In the Gospel, Jesus reads from the prophet Isaiah when he reaches the synagogue at Nazareth, his hometown. He sets before the people a new way of life, announcing that he is God's anointed one. His mission is to bring good news to the poor, proclaiming liberty to captives and freeing the downtrodden.

What is the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord?

The feast commemorates the presentation of Jesus in the Temple in Jerusalem as a baby.

The feast is also known as Candlemas Day because candles are blessed to symbolize Christ as the light of the world.






